l've never had such an awful meal. (Never)	Never have I had such an awful meal.
You rarely see such beautiful workmanship. (Rarely)	Rarely do you see such beautiful workmanship.
He didn't say a word. (Not)	Not a word did he say.
They couldn't hear a sound. (Not)	Not a sound could they hear.
He wouldn't accept a penny. (Not)	Not a penny would he accept.
Quick! We mustn't waste a minute. (Not)	Quick! Not a minute must we waste.
He didn't thank us once. (Not)	Not once did he thank us.
We won't pay one dollar more. (Not)	Not one dollar more will we pay.
She only passed by cheating. (Only)	Only by cheating did she pass.
She wouldn't speak to him until he apologized. (Not until)	Not until he apologized would she speak to him.
I only realized my mistake when I saw the answers. (Only)	Only when I saw the answers did I realize my mistake.
She only said she loved him when he was on his death bed. (Only)	Only when he was on his death bed did she say she loved him.
I've never been so insulted. (Never)	Never have I been so insulted.
They only survived by eating plants and insects. (Only)	Only by eating plants and insects did they survive.
