

Adverbials - negative and limiting

I've never had such an awful meal. (Never)	<i>Never have I had such an awful meal.</i>
You rarely see such beautiful workmanship. (Rarely)	<i>Rarely do you see such beautiful workmanship.</i>
He didn't say a word. (Not)	<i>Not a word did he say.</i>
They couldn't hear a sound. (Not)	<i>Not a sound could they hear.</i>
He wouldn't accept a penny. (Not)	<i>Not a penny would he accept.</i>
Quick! We mustn't waste a minute. (Not)	<i>Quick! Not a minute must we waste.</i>
He didn't thank us once. (Not)	<i>Not once did he thank us.</i>
We won't pay one dollar more. (Not)	<i>Not one dollar more will we pay.</i>
She only passed by cheating. (Only)	<i>Only by cheating did she pass.</i>
She wouldn't speak to him until he apologized. (Not until)	<i>Not until he apologized would she speak to him.</i>
I only realized my mistake when I saw the answers. (Only)	<i>Only when I saw the answers did I realize my mistake.</i>
She only said she loved him when he was on his death bed. (Only)	<i>Only when he was on his death bed did she say she loved him.</i>
I've never been so insulted. (Never)	<i>Never have I been so insulted.</i>
They only survived by eating plants and insects. (Only)	<i>Only by eating plants and insects did they survive.</i>
