She fired / was fired most of the office staff in a fit of rage.

The goods still have not arrived even though they were sent three weeks ago.

**Choose the verb form**

The bell rang / was rung and the children ran into the playground for their break.

The weather changed / was changed so we cancelled the picnic.

If ice-cream melts / is melted, it shouldn't freeze / be frozen again.

If ice-cream melts...
