<p>1</p> <p>I'm working for an insurance company.</p> <p>Wrong I work for an insurance company. (Present simple for a permanent situation.)</p>	<p>2</p> <p>I will start work at nine every day.</p> <p>Wrong I go swimming once a week. ('Will' is not used for common routines.)</p>	<p>3</p> <p>Who are you work with?</p> <p>Wrong Who do you work with?</p>
<p>4</p> <p>I'm not liking this movie - it's so boring.</p> <p>Wrong I don't like this movie - it's so boring. ('Like' is a state verb.)</p>	<p>5</p> <p>What do you usually have for breakfast?</p> <p>Correct!</p>	<p>6</p> <p>What are you doing at work this week?</p> <p>Correct! ('This week' is a temporary period of time around now.)</p>
<p>7</p> <p>Are you being busy at work at the moment?</p> <p>Wrong Are you busy at work at the moment? ('Be' is a state verb.)</p>	<p>8</p> <p>I take this course to improve my grammar.</p> <p>Wrong I am taking this course to improve my grammar. (This is a temporary situation.)</p>	<p>9</p> <p>Are you have your lunch in the office or do you go out?</p> <p>Wrong Do you have your lunch in the office or do you go out?</p>
<p>10</p> <p>The air pollution in many cities gets worse.</p> <p>Wrong The air pollution in many cities is getting worse. (This is a changing situation.)</p>	<p>11</p> <p>Who does cook dinner in your family?</p> <p>Wrong Who cooks dinner in your family? (This is a subject question.)</p>	<p>12</p> <p>My sister is always borrowing my clothes without asking.</p> <p>Correct! (Present simple + 'always' or 'forever' can be used for irritating situations.)</p>
